**DAVID CRANE, *PRESIDENT & CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, NRG ENERGY, INC.***

David Crane is the President and CEO of NRG Energy, a Fortune 300 electric power generation company changing how people think about and use energy. NRG – one of the largest solar power developers in the country – is a pioneer in developing cleaner and smarter energy choices for consumers. The Company is building the country's first privately funded electric vehicle charging infrastructure and, through its retail subsidiaries, offers consumers the latest smart energy solutions to better manage their energy use. Under Crane's leadership, NRG doubled its size to more than 25,000 megawatts generation of capacity – enough to power approximately 20 million homes. NRG's retail businesses serve more than two million residential, business, commercial and industrial customers. As part of Crane's commitment to low and no carbon generation, NRG owns four wind farms in Texas and the largest photovoltaic solar field in California. In total, the Company has more than 2,000 MW of solar projects under development or in construction across the southwestern United States. Additionally, in 2010, both Crane and NRG were recognized by the Clinton Global Initiative for funding a project to expand the use of solar power in Haiti. To help promote the adoption of electric vehicles, NRG is partnering with electric vehicle manufacturers and other companies and – through its Reliant retail subsidiary – building vehicle charging infrastructure in Houston, Dallas and Fort Worth, Texas. The Company's other clean energy initiatives include developing a biomass facility in Connecticut and a commercial-scale carbon capture demonstration project at one of its Texas coal plants. Prior to joining NRG, Crane was CEO of International Power and held positions at Lehman Brothers and ABB Energy Ventures. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs and a Juris Doctor degree from Harvard Law School.

**VINCENT SCHÄCHTER, *VICE PRESIDENT, RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT, TOTAL SA***

Dr. Vincent Schächter is Vice President, Research and Development, at Total Gas & Power. Dr. Schächter is responsible for Total's R&D programs and partnerships in cleantech, including solar (Photovoltaics and Concentrated Solar Power), Carbon Capture and Storage, energy storage and biotechnology. The network of R&D partnerships he is developing includes start-ups such as Amyris, Konarka, and AEP, as well as several academic institutes in the US and in Europe. Before moving to TOTAL in 2009 to start the biotechnology R&D effort, Dr. Schächter was head of the Computational Systems Biology Laboratory at the Institute for Genomics of CEA (Commissariat à l'Energie Atomique), a large French government research organization. Dr. Schächter's research there focused on the reconstruction and analysis of genome-scale metabolic models using high-throughput experimental data. His group coordinated or participated in several EU projects in systems biology and computational biology (MICROME, ENFIN, Biosapiens, TARPOL). Dr. Schächter has organized several international scientific meetings. He also acquired applied experience first as Director of Bioinformatics Research at Hybrigenics SA, a biotechnology company, then as Director of Bioinformatics at Genoscope, the French national Genome Center. Vincent Schächter holds a PhD in mathematics from the Ecole Normale Supérieure in Paris.

**MICHAEL BRUNE, *EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, SIERRA CLUB***

Michael Brune holds degrees in Economics and Finance from West Chester University in Pennsylvania and comes to the Sierra Club from the Rainforest Action Network, where he served seven years as executive director. Under Mr. Brune's leadership, Rainforest Action Network has won more than a dozen key environmental commitments from America's largest corporations, including Home Depot, Citi, Goldman Sachs, Bank of America, Kinko's, Boise, and Lowe's. Mr. Brune's critically acclaimed book, *Coming Clean -- Breaking America's Addiction to Oil and Coal*, published by Sierra Club Books in 2008, details a plan for a new green economy that will create well-paying jobs, promote environmental justice and bolster national security. He and his wife, Mary, attribute their ongoing passion for environmental activism in part to concern that their outdoors-loving children, Olivia and Sebastian, inherit a healthy world. Mr. Brune is particularly interested in promoting programs that link the Club's traditional protection of wild places, including National Parks, to urgently needed climate change solutions.

**GEORGE KELL, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, UNITED NATIONS GLOBAL COMPACT**

Georg Kell is the Executive Director of the United Nations Global Compact, the world's largest voluntary corporate responsibility initiative with more than 6,000 participants in over 130 countries. Spanning more than two decades, his career with the United Nations began in 1987 at the UN Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) in Geneva. In 1997, Mr. Kell joined the Office of the UN Secretary-General in New York, where he spearheaded the development of new strategies to enhance private sector engagement with the work of the United Nations. As one of the Global Compact's key architects, he has led the initiative since its launch in 2000, building the most widely recognized global business platform on human rights, labour, environment, and anti-corruption. Prior to joining the UN System, Mr. Kell worked as a researcher at the Fraunhofer Institute in Germany and as a financial analyst evaluating multinational companies' investment portfolios in Asia and Africa. A native of Germany, he holds advanced degrees in economics and engineering from the Technical University of Berlin.

**ROBERT ORR, UNITED NATIONS ASSISTANT SECRETARY GENERAL FOR STRATEGIC PLANNING AND POLICY COORDINATION, PRINCIPAL POLICY ADVISOR TO THE UN SECRETARY GENERAL ON CLIMATE CHANGE**

Dr. Robert C. Orr has served as the Assistant Secretary-General for Strategic Planning and Policy Coordination in the Executive Office of the Secretary-General since 2004. His responsibilities include running the Secretary-General's Policy Committee and serving as the principal policy advisor to the Secretary-General on climate change, energy, food security, global health and counter-terrorism. Dr. Orr joined the United Nations from Harvard University where he served as the Executive Director of the Belfer Center for Science and International Affairs at the Kennedy School of Government. Prior to this, he served as Director of the Council on Foreign Relations in Washington, D.C. From 1996 to 2001, Dr. Orr served in senior posts in the Government of the United States, including Deputy to the U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations and Director of the USUN Washington office, where he was instrumental in securing an agreement to have the United States pay its arrears to the United Nations. He also served as Director of Global and Multilateral Affairs at the National Security Council, where he was responsible for peacekeeping and humanitarian affairs. Dr. Orr has published extensively on post-conflict reconstruction, the United Nations, peacekeeping, and democracy promotion. His publications include *Winning the Peace: an American Strategy for Post-Conflict Reconstruction* (CSIS Press, 2004) and *Keeping the Peace: Multidimensional UN Operations in Cambodia and El Salvador* (Cambridge University Press, 1997). Dr. Orr received his Ph.D. and M.P.A. in International Relations from the Woodrow Wilson School at Princeton University, and his bachelor's degree from the University of California Los Angeles (UCLA). He speaks Spanish and Mandarin.

**JUNFENG LI, DIRECTOR GENERAL, NATIONAL CENTRE OF CLIMATE CHANGE STRATEGY RESEARCH (NCCS)**

Mr. Li Junfeng is currently serving as the Deputy Director General of the Energy Research Institute's (ERI) National Development and Reform Commission. Mr. Li also holds professional and academic positions as a Professor and the Chair of the Academic Committee of ERI, Science & Technology Advisor to Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region, board member of Global Wind Energy Council, Vice-Chairman of the Renewable Energy Policy Network (REN21), etc. Mr. Li graduated from Shandong Mining Institute in 1982. Mr. Li is the focal point of the Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Partnership (REEEP) program for the Region of East Asia.
