David Crane is the President and CEO of NRG Energy, a Fortune 300 electric power generation company changing how people think about and use energy. NRG – one of the largest solar power developers in the country – is a pioneer in developing cleaner and smarter energy choices for consumers. The Company is building the country's first privately funded electric vehicle charging infrastructure and, through its retail subsidiaries, offers consumers the latest smart energy solutions to better manage their energy use. Under Crane's leadership, NRG doubled its size to more than 25,000 megawatts generation of capacity – enough to power approximately 20 million homes. NRG's retail businesses serve more than two million residential, business, commercial and industrial customers. As part of Crane's commitment to low and no carbon generation, NRG owns four wind farms in Texas and the largest photovoltaic solar field in California. In total, the Company has more than 2,000 MW of solar projects under development or in construction across the southwestern United States. Additionally, in 2010, both Crane and NRG were recognized by the Clinton Global Initiative for funding a project to expand the use of solar power in Haiti. To help promote the adoption of electric vehicles, NRG is partnering with electric vehicle manufacturers and other companies and – through its Reliant retail subsidiary – building vehicle charging infrastructure in Houston, Dallas and Fort Worth, Texas. The Company's other clean energy initiatives include developing a biomass facility in Connecticut and a commercial-scale carbon capture demonstration project at one of its Texas coal plants. Prior to joining NRG, Crane was CEO of International Power and held positions at Lehman Brothers and ABB Energy Ventures. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs and a Juris Doctor degree from Harvard Law School.
